With the College in abeyance I have removed St Gildas from the Ynys Fawr Website, as there is little point in advertising the existence of a College Group when we don't have one; however should there be enough College Members willing to stand in the required SCA positions then the College web presence will be restored.

The Tasmanian Community Fund Grant Application

The Tasmanian Community Fund received 293 applications requesting \$17.24 million in Grant Round 26. After careful consideration of each application, the Tasmanian Community Fund Board approved grants totalling \$2.60 million to 87 projects. This takes the total amount of funding awarded since 2000 to over \$65 million to more than 2000 projects in all areas of the State.

Unfortunately the Barony was unsuccessful this round, however there are still more rounds available, we as a Barony need to decide if this is the right grant for us? In order to be successful we need to demonstrate that we can contribute to the greater community beyond our membership base. I have to ask if this is the right grant for us. I am willing to continue to submit applications including the Tasmanian Community Fund but it will need some serious thought before we submit anything for Round 27.

The Canton of Lightwood Seneschal: Adelindis filia Gotefridi (Liz Williamson)

Proposed Events: We have reconsidered our proposed dates in regard to feedback from the last Baronial meeting. We've cancelled the proposed feast at the end of June due to too little time to advertise, and decided that given the number of events in the rest of the Barony towards the end of the year, we will support them rather than field our own events in September and December. So we would now like to propose a potluck feast at Surges Bay on 24 August, which is two weeks before the event in Kempton, and gives us plenty of time to advertise.

Imots: We were forced to cancel the potluck Imot on 25 May due to a blackout in Geeveston. It has been rescheduled to 22 June. At the Imot on 8 June we discussed and agreed on the suggestion to limit business meetings to the first Imot of the month, and to devote the subsequent Imots to pleasure with either potluck dinners or more Arts and Sciences. Adelindis volunteered to look into arranging more A&S activities.

New Members: We added three new members to our rolls in May, with the family who first discovered the Canton at the Easter camping event taking out a family membership, and coming along to archery and the beginner fighter training course.

Petition: The group wishes to start the process of petitioning to be recognised officially as a Canton. We are happy to set up a bank account when we have the details from the Reeve. We would prefer to use the Bendigo Bank as it has strong community ties and we have approached them for fundraising in the past, and most likely will again.

Necessary Requirements for Lightwood to Become a Real Live Canton!

According to the Kingdom Seneschal the Canton needs the following:

- 1. Have existed for at least a year
- 2. Have a registered name
- 3. Have been reporting correctly
- 4. Get a bank account set up
- 5. Run events and activities
- 6. Petition the Kingdom Seneschal, who will petition the Board and the Crown.

Addressing these:

- 1. The group was acknowledged by Baron Lucas in December 2011 at the Kraken Picnic, and in March 2012 by Their Majesties Siridean and Margie at the Feast of the Lions. We were acknowledged as proposed or incipient or whatever the official term is at the BoD meeting at Rowany Festival 2012. As a group, we have been operating since at least September 2011.
- 2. According to the Ordinary and Armorial: Lightwood, Canton of This branch-name was registered in May of 2012 (via Lochac). The following device associated with this name was registered in May of 2012 (via Lochac): Quarterly gules and argent, an apple tree Or fructed gules within a laurel wreath counter changed.

- 3. The Canton Seneschal has been reporting as appropriate, and our other officers have reported to her during the course of IMOT's and other activities.
- 4. We are ready to set up a bank account any time, but I presume we need approval from the Reeve. Sadly, the only email address I have for Dawn is her yahoo.com.au one, which I believe she dumped.

- 5. We have run several events, including pot luck feasts, the baronial investiture, and the Lightwood Easter Festivity. We have fortnightly archery (nine people came along last week), imots and fighter practice, plus monthly A&S evenings at Oz's place. We've been doing the imots for over a year now, and the other stuff for the last four months or so.
- 6. No doubt I can whip up something to send to the KS, though it would be nice to have a ceremony in court some time. The next Royal Visit (Declan's rapier thingy in September, I believe?) may be too soon, and not really suitable given the location. We're still discussing this bit.

Seneschal: I'm happy for the Canton to proceed. In fact the following was sent to our Reeve for approval.

Hi Dawn,

Just a heads up before tomorrow's meeting.

The Canton would like to set up its own Bank Account, and progress to becoming a real live Canton. Huzzah! I am satisfied that the Canton is completing the required amount of Reporting, that their Officers are confident and efficient, I can see no reason why the Canton cannot proceed and in fact encourage them to do so.

As you are the Reeve for the Barony they require your approval to set up a Bank Account, subject to your approval I would consider their preferred banking establishment to be the obvious choice.

I and the Canton look forward to your decision at tomorrow's meeting.
