Hoardward is an annual competition intended to promote and celebrate early period (as in, pre-1000) play within the SCA. Each year's competition has a different theme. The theme for the current theme is "The Life of a Dark Ages Craftsman." This means participants are looking at crafts as practised in the Dark Ages, with a craft being any activity that makes something (such as a wood working, jewellery making, animal husbandry.). The winner is determined by popular acclaim; by the entrants in the competition, and any other interested people. The prize is a Hoard of items as contributed by participants and any interested parties. The competition will be judged at Festival in 2014.

SOUNDS INTERESTING. HOW DO I ENTER?

Participants must make a declaration or "Boast" outlining what craft they intend to look at in their Hoardward entry. They must also make a Pledge to the Hoard, which is the prize.

TELL ME MORE ABOUT THIS PLEDGE, AND THE HOARD.

The Pledges go to make up the Hoard which the winner of the competition receives. This can be any item of beauty, value or usefulness that's related to the pre-1000 period. Think about the sort of things found in historical hoards - jewellery, weapons, beautiful table ware, well-made clothes, or money. Other great pledges would be quality raw materials or tools for crafts (such as beautiful material, furs, a number of natural dyed skeins of wool, or a selection of leatherworking tools), or quality reference books to do with the early period (a pledge for an earlier competition was an archaeological report for a significant Anglo-Saxon cemetery). And if all else fails, a bag of gold coins would be fine for a pledge - historically accurate, and I'm sure gratefully received! Once the winner receives the Hoard, he or she can keep as much of it as they want, or distribute pieces to people who helped in the project or to good friends as he or she sees fit.

HOW IS IT JUDGED?

Participants should produce a crafted item related to their Boast, along with documentation and a presentation. Ideally, this should include reflections on what you learned during your project, and what impact you think your craft would have held in period. Judging will take place towards the end of Festival, and will be judged by the participants of the current competition, along with other interested parties (such as early period-focussed Laurels, or early period players).

Because it's part of Festival, I would strongly encourage participants to teach a collegium at Festival related to the craft they studied - after all, we are supposed to be promoting Early Period play.

CAN I COMPETE IN A TEAM?

As some crafts work better with a team, yes you can. However, you should do an individual submission, because even in a team participants will learn different things during the project. Your individual submission should include an individual item, but this can be related to the items produced by your team mates. And remember, you'll be judged against individual entrants.

HOW DO I MAKE A BOAST AND A PLEDGE?

The Hoard will be at Spring War in Mordenvale, from 4-7 October 2013. You can make your Boast and Pledge there, or send it to Spring War. If you can't make it to Spring War or decide to enter after, you have up to October 20 to get your pledge to me (Leoba of Lecelad). PLEASE NOTE, PROMISSORY PLEDGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED unless you get your Pledge to me within two weeks of making your Boast and stating your Pledge.

You can also make your intentions known online - there is a Hoardward Facebook group and website (see below for details). But again, you must arrange to get your actual Pledge to me within two weeks of making the Pledge. The deadline for online declarations is October 20.

I CAN'T COMPETE, BUT THIS SOUNDS LIKE A GREAT IDEA SO I'D LOVE TO CONTRIBUTE SOMETHING TO THE HOARD.

Any contributions of items to the Hoard will be gratefully received, by me and all participants, and whoever wins!

* Guillaume d'Oze. Device. Quarterly gules semy-de-lys Or and azure, a boar passant argent.

* Helewyse de Bonnay. Name and device. Or, two pallets purpure and a bordure gules.

This name mixes an English given name and a French byname; this is an allowable lingual mix under Appendix C of SENA.

* Kateryna de Bonnay. Name.

* Mariot de Bonnay. Name and device. Vert, on a bend Or three mullets purpure.

Brunissende Dragonette was able to date Mariot as a French name to 1571, in *Pratique de l'art des notaires* by Gabriel Cotier (<http://books.google.com/books?id=wVVFlaDAbXAC>, p. 442).

* Robert de Bonnay. Name and device. Barry wavy Or and purpure, on a sea-horse gules a cross flory argent.

Nice 15th century French name!

* Talia de Bonnay. Name and device. Per chevron purpure and gules, a centaur statant Or and in base a cross of Calvary argent.

This name mixes an Italian given name and a French byname; this is an allowable lingual mix under Appendix C of SENA.

If anyone's keeping count, that is every single submission from the canton of Lightwood, all approved and registered. Only one change (the paly field on Helewyse's device is now a field with two thin pales, or pallets) but that doesn't matter in practice.
