There is a lot of stuff from the Seneschal's meeting that was held at Festival. I will have a copy of these minutes at the meeting for anyone wanting to read them.

Some other points of note from the Kingdom Seneschal are:

- The new Nominated Caregiver form is here <http://sca.org.au/board/nomination-of-caregiver>
- There has been a clarification on the Member without an Indemnity because this has been an issue. If a member can prove membership but not an indemnity they do not have to pay the \$5 insurance levy in Australia.
- Anything that needs the presence of the Crown must be advertised in Pegasus. Anything that does not need the presence of the Crown but that does need to have awards given out at must at the very least be advertised in a local newsletter but does not need to be advertised in Pegasus. However any event that is having awards given out at should be an official event which means it needs to be approved by the group Seneschal which means it should be going through the online event form and that automatically forwards events to Pegasus. So this should no longer be an issue. If you are having events run they should be going through that online form.
- At this stage there is no specific media policy for SCA Ltd.

Important things to remember: there should be a local representative to talk to the Media when members of the Media are around. That representative should be the Seneschal or someone that is agreed upon by the group as a whole.

Every attempt should be made to represent the SCA in a positive light that includes no references to "The Society for Consenting Adults" etc. Australian Privacy Laws should be abided by <http://www.oaic.gov.au/privacy/privacy-act/the-privacy-act> (the current SCA Ltd Privacy Policy is out of date and does not really cover this side of things but if you need it, it can be accessed here http://sca.org.au/wp-content/uploads/2013/07/SCAA_Privacy_Policy.pdf. Aside from that I would suggest that you get some information about what they want to do and talk to your group about it. If possible it would be best if the SCA could at least have a look at any articles before they go out but that is often not possible. It is also a good idea for you to request that you be given access to a copy of any articles that go out. This is often done electronically.

Medieval Garden Bed at Royal Botanical Gardens

Cary has made a formal proposal, but is looking at doing a display changing seasonally. We will centre it around a recipe and plant the appropriate plants for that recipe. We will try and find unusual plants (and the Gardens will help source these) and old cultivars. I mentioned skirrets and was told 'that sounds good' (and they knew what they were).

We need to know who wants to help, how often we want to tend things and come up with some good starting recipes with unusual ingredients.

Action: So, who wants to be in this adventure and what do we want to plant?

Officers, Rules and Regulations

We are currently looking at writing up a policy to state clearly what should be done for people who "blow in" at a training session. Currently the rules are that they MUST pay the \$5 insurance fee as they are not covered for insurance otherwise. People no longer get entry to their first event free. This is due to the \$5 insurance that HAS to now be charged.

Archery at the Hobart Show Grounds

With regard to RAST's request for a detailed Safety Plan for Archery!

Kevin Hotson suggested that we submit two plans one for Blunts at the start, they can then observe that in action, then develop the plan further to cover points.

Seneschal: This is a great idea. If one of the Archery Marshal's or anyone else is willing to volunteer and write this up that would be fantastic.

Action: Write up Archery Safety Plan for blunts to be used at RAST

Carpeting the New Hall

With regard to RAST's Lease Condition that we recarpet the Hall!

Cary Lenehan has a contact at Carpet Choice that may have what we need at a very good price.

Seneschal: I dub Cary Official "Flying Carpet Purveyor" and to oversee the new carpet purchase.

New Business

Great Southern Gathering

Seneschal: Has the walk through of Orana happened yet? And should we send an invite to the Crown Prince and Princess' Chamberlain to put it on the calendar for their procession?

Leather Purchase from Anton D'Stoc

Anton has found a large (~3,500) hides of leather that Lochac can purchase for 20grand. Currently Ynys fawr is in with Lost wayfarers for one share (1,000 dollars worth = ~175 hides). Nicole is currently co-ordinating this.

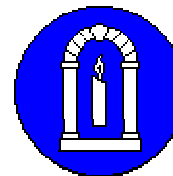
Lightwood has put in for \$100, Damien has put in \$200, Taryn has put in \$200 and Jen has put in \$100. If the Barony puts in \$400 we can get 1 share between us and spilt it. Taryn and Jen are from Rowany and are willing to be our reps on the day and transport and store our leather until suitable shipping can be arranged and paid for. Taryn has also said she is willing to shout an Ursulan martyr to help get our stuff out quickly in the chaos.

Anton is sacking the leather store on May 31st so this needs to be sorted out quickly.

I have told Jen and Taryn we would prefer harder, thicker armour grade leather for heavy and archery. Belt leather weight and length would be good in any colour and any other good 2-3mm pieces of leather would be appreciated. They are happy with this as they mostly want thinner garment leather. We can on sell the leather to people in YF after it is here.

Seneschal: Do we want in and if so is \$400 too much? Does anyone know of cheap freight from Sydney to Tassie?

Each Sunday there is archery and sewing alongside heavy combat practice, on the first Sunday of each month there is also dancing.

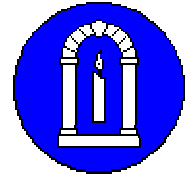
Every second Saturday, and first Sunday of each month, there are general A&S activities in two of our remote subgroups.

Webwright's Quarterly Report

During the past quarter both the North/North West and East Coast geographic regions of Ynys Fawr have added Facebook groups. I have been in contact with the administrators of both groups and have their agreement that these groups will be used only for subject matter specific to their geographic groups. Anything that may be of interest to the Barony as a whole will be posted on the SCA Tasmania group which will still serve as the primary information dissemination point for Ynys Fawr. At this point in time both Ynys Fawr and the Canton of Lightwood have websites, and there are four separate Facebook groups.

I have also updated the Order of Precedence on the Ynys Fawr website, on a roughly monthly basis. The website has a link to a google document which is the Order of Precedence for Ynys Fawr; and which is maintained separate to the website.

I have also added a number of links to various event stewarding help pages, including two specifically Lochac oriented pages.

Tropfest Film Update

At our Rowany Festival meeting I undertook to liaise with Justin in regards to the film 'The Kingdom' that was shot at last years Rowany Festival and his new project that we all (I believe) received an email requesting sponsorship of a fighter etc.

I have had a lengthy chat with him on what is happening and below is a summary of the discussion.

He has 2 separate projects- the first is The Kingdom, which most of us have seen in part or the first draft release that was on vimeo. He is also working on a separate and new project.

Info so far:

The Kingdom

- The Kingdom was a pseudo documentary filmed at Rowany Festival that told the story of Bad Baron Bain's 'pilgrimage' to the lands of Rowany had a draft version posted on Vimeo (which some thought was inappropriately 'tagged')
- this version had been retagged. This was shared on facebook again last week. I let Justin know and he has since removed it from Vimeo as he is wanting to now put the focus on the finished product.
- He will be sending me a copy of the final cut to review
- he is working on an online space that can be protected to house the finished product so all seneschals can see it
- he will keep me informed as this develops.
- he is trying to pitch this concept as an idea to places like the ABC and SBS as an ongoing series telling stories from within the SCA
- he is aware that this would need to involve heavier discussion with the SCA and a framework established if it were to go ahead
- he has followed all required processes to date contacting SCA media advisor at society level and following guidelines given to our Kingdom level) to be able to create The Kingdom and I am confident he will work with us correctly should anything further go ahead.

NEW PROJECT

- His new project is the reason we all received the email discussed previously - it has a working title (something french) (that is not the working title- but a description of it)
- It is a separate concept and project to The Kingdom
- It will be a standalone web series - scripted storyline that he is currently in preproduction / concept development for.
- It is not ready for production at this stage.
- It is NOT based on the SCA
- I believe his intentions are pure and he is not trying to explicitly exploit the SCA or its members.
- The new Project does not require SCA involvement to continue - we would be attached later in the process.
- He thought that connecting the SCA in some way to the project (using barony names and devices) could create a potential marketing opportunity for the SCA (this is a very clever idea) with web links to the SCA for people interested in finding out more about us.
- We discussed the potential; perceptions that story lines and positioning could create (positive and negative) and the mundane and privacy logistics around this happening - there is a lot to consider - I made this clear - I told him I suspect it would lead to a formal contract if it went ahead - he understands.
- He will come back to me when he has more to offer around the development of the project, story lines, schedule etc to further the discussion

I am keen to see where this develops and I believe if done correctly could be a wonderful opportunity for us to extend our exposure in a new way.
