New Business

Hall rate decrease

On behalf of Baroness Madelaine: We are indeed fortunate to have the hall on a 24/7 basis and it appears we are beginning to have about 3 days a week usage. This is rather good as compared to how often we got to use Cambridge hall, and we have all acknowledged this. So I would like to put it to the Barony that we should review the entry fee, and if possible, to bring it down to \$2 a head once more.

Personally, I find \$3 fairly easy to pay, until the two of us have to come from the one purse. Compare the current spend of \$6 from one purse, to the previous \$4, and suddenly it becomes difficult if we were to come more than once a fortnight to the hall, and I am wondering if other couples feel similarly. For visitors, \$8 seems just a bit too close to \$10 in your head, especially if it's just a look and not actively doing stuff. \$7 just seems less of a barrier, and all things, in the end, are about how you feel when making a choice.

I would also like to find clarification about Social Night, if it also attracts a fee to attend if it's at the hall?

Naming the Hall

On behalf of Baroness Madelaine: Shall we agree that the name of the hall will be Kraken Hall? If so perhaps we can do a painted sign for the outside where there is a billbboard on the wall?

Coronets

Cary and Maddie had a visit from Jack Voutnis to talk about making the new coronets. They have given him the specs and he will get back with a price. The timeline is for one to be finished by the end of March (so Maddie can wear it at festival) and the other by the following November. Maddie will also be asking Vaughan if he would like to quote. It's worth noting that we are expecting some rubies and emeralds so the timing for finalising a design will be dependent on the arrival of those gems, also worth noting that to make a coronet it will take at least a couple of hundred hours of work, whoever makes them. This also means the use of lapis will be limited if any at all. Also Jack has suggested no enamelling due to it bumping up the cost and including another artisan to do it.
