Items for the Hall

As discussed at last meeting we don't wish for the hall to turn into a mundane dumping ground. So to this end I (Nicole) would like it minuted that if people wish to bring items to the hall they need to already be Baronial items (e.g. Gold Key) or they have to be passed at a meeting where at least 6 paid members are present, including either of the B&B's, the Seneschal and one other major office holder.

Uses for left over Lapis

Seneschal: Do people wish to have rings of state, a Seneschal's chain or something else made out of the left over Lapis from the Coronets?

Monthly A&S and Baric Arts nights

Lorix wishes to run a monthly A&S day/night on either the Fri/Sat at the end of each month (except Mar and Dec). Would people be interested in this and what nights/weeks suit people better?

Cary wishes to run a monthly bardic arts night once a month. Would people be interested in this and what nights/weeks suit people better?

Monthly Hall Fee for Regulars

Kevin raised the idea that we should have a discounted rate for people who attend the hall regularly for events. He put forward the price of \$15/month for unlimited hall access. This could be useful for people who come regularly, in couples or can't afford to pay more to come to lots of regular activities.

Seneschal: After doing a quick back of the envelope calculation of a standard 4 week month were you attend just rapier, mid-week and sunday trainings (currently \$6/week). It would be \$24 a month to attend just these events (without dance, A&S, bardic stuff and actual events). I would be happy to put a price of \$20/month out there as this is still a discount on the \$24 you would normally pay to attend these activities but would ensure we didn't make a large loss if everyone started paying the \$20/month.

New Business

Entertainment book fundraiser

I have been contacted by the Entertainment Book people and wanted to know if people would be interested in this as a fundraising idea. Each book costs \$60 but has LOADS of coupons inside that will save you heaps. For each book sold the group gets \$12 in fundraising. We can sell books to people not in the group but we do need to have their money up front to pay for the books. I have more details in an email if people are interested.

This is mostly as she can not attend due to work commitments at the moment and feels she is missing a lot of information by not being at the meeting itself.
